In order to foster a better understanding of the functions of the Park Police and to enhance the existing cooperative effort with the community, the Prince George's County Division of the Maryland-National Capital Park Police offers a six week Park/Community Volunteer Academy. Classes meet one evening per week for two and one-half hours per night, from 7:00 - 9:30 p.m., throughout the program. Classes include: Problem Oriented Policing, Traffic Control, Search & Rescue, Judgemental Shooting, and CPR.

Participants are encouraged to ride-along with an on-duty patrol officer during the program. Following completion of the program, graduates may join the Park Police Volunteer Association and volunteer in various capacities with the Park Police. Training may be conducted at Park Police Headquarters or other locations.
